

HUT AND HAPPENING – BOURNEMOUTH OFFERS MORE BEACHFRONT BARGAINS

If you do like to be beside the seaside, this Sunday is the time to stake your claim to a patch of Bournemouth's beachfront.

From 10.00am on July 4 – Independence Day – 25-year leases on brand new beach huts at the foot of Alum Chine go up for grabs.

The New England-style huts are selling for the equivalent of just £23 per week, and those who clinch the deal on the day will save a whopping £550 in annual service charges.

Laid out in an informal "village" setting, the huts benefit from the shady wooded chine gardens to the rear, and from a sun-soaked promenade position just yards from Bournemouth's blue-flagged beaches to the front.

A special Alum Chine Family Open Day has been planned to allow mums and dads to get down to beach-side business without pester-power distractions.

Junior family members are being offered free volleyball "taster sessions" as well as the chance to chill out in Alum Chine's splash pool or run wild in the gorgeous gardens.

Bournemouth now has more beach huts than any other resort in the UK, but demand remains phenomenally high.

The new Alum Chine huts benefit from 24-hour, 365-day CCTV surveillance, while the beach is patrolled by seafront rangers and RNLI lifeguards throughout the peak holiday months.
