

Cycling on the promenade



Please help us ensure that Bournemouth and Poole Seafront remains a safe and enjoyable place for all visitors.

Time restrictions - For the months of July and August no cycling is permitted on the Seafront between 10am and 6pm. When cycling is permitted, the following restrictions apply:



Cyclists and pedestrians

The promenade is to be used and enjoyed by pedestrians and cyclists together. Cyclists Must Give Way To Pedestrians - They Have The Right Of Way.



Cycle Slowly

When cycling on the promenade keep your speed down. Please don't cycle more than 10mph.



Dismount

Please dismount and push your bike when you see this sign.



No cycling

Where you see this sign cycling is prohibited at all times. Please be a responsible cyclist - dismount and Push Your Bike.

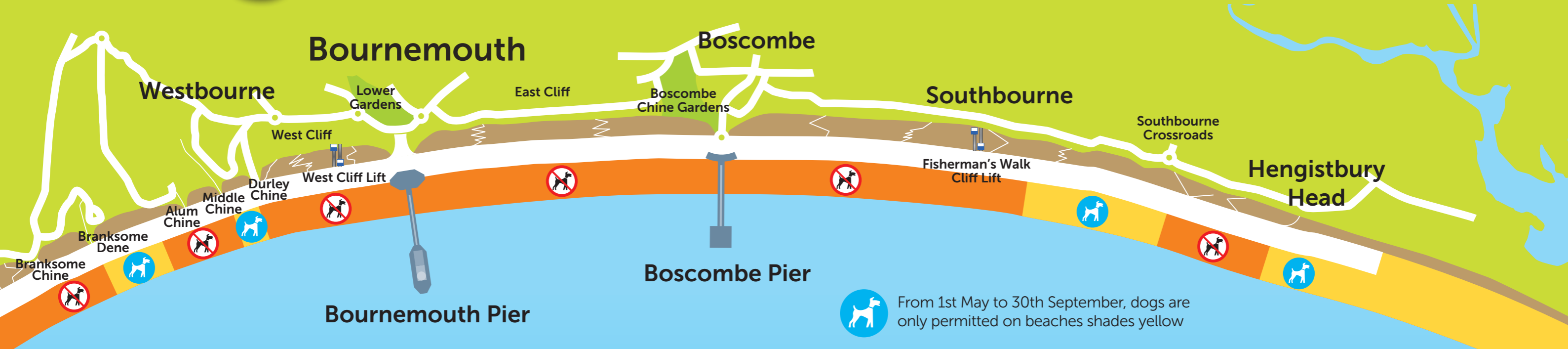

Between 1st May and 30th September dogs are banned from the beach except for areas shown on the map in blue which have been set aside for the exercise of dogs.



Dogs on leads

From 1st May to 30th September, dogs must be kept on a lead when on the promenade, Bournemouth and Boscombe Piers, cliff paths and zig zags.
