Priorities for 2018

- 1. Joint Working to ensure that the status of the Resort Director role is maintained and the best calibre person appointed within a given timeframe
- 2. International Education Expand Bournemouth and Poole's profile internationally as educational tourism destinations and fully engage in the Government consultation.
- 3. To ensure that Tourism has a voice and input in both Bournemouth and Poole's Local Plans.
- 4. Skills Shortage Ensure full engagement with the Government, Dorset LEP and Visit Britain to address issues including staffing, work opportunities for international students and skill shortages within tourism related industries.
- 5. Funding identifying funding opportunities and streams particularly through the industrial strategy
- 6. To promote as widely as possible the importance of the contribution that tourism directly and indirectly has on the local economy and how it benefits residents.
- 7. To work with transport and a range of relevant stakeholders to address the issues surrounding congestion, wayfinding and public transport and in particular the impact of roadworks across the conurbation
