- How much does it cost to enter? Half Marathon: £24 (£22 UKA affiliated runner) 10K: £18 (£16 UKA Affiliated runner) 5K: £7 (£8 on the day) 1K: £5 (£6 on the day)
- Can children run? As recommended by UKA is a minimum age on each race, bar the 1K which any age can run Half Marathon: 17 years 10K: 15 years 5K: 11 years
