



Bournemouth Beach Hut Hire Terms and Conditions

- Beach Huts and Pods are for daytime use only (dawn till dusk) and may not be used for overnight accommodation.
- Beach Hut keys will be available from 10.00am on the first day of your booking from the Beach Office indicated on your booking confirmation, and keys must be returned by dusk on or before the final day of your booking.
- Beach Huts and Pods are to be used as a private beach hut for leisure purposes associated with the adjoining beach and sea only and not for the advertisement display or sale of goods products or services.
- Use of the Beach Hut and Pods is restricted to six persons and the Hirer shall be responsible for the good behaviour of all persons using the Beach Hut or Pod.
- The Hirer must be considerate of neighbouring beach hut tenants regarding space outside beach huts, music and noise and shall not cause or permit a nuisance in or around the Beach Hut or Pod which shall cause annoyance, inconvenience or disturbance to occupiers of neighbouring huts/ pods or to the public.
- Smoking is prohibited in all Beach Huts and Pods.
- The Beach Hut is furnished with three deckchairs, gas ring and bottle. A Beach Pod is equipped with electric, a microwave, a kettle and a table & chairs. Please note that no crockery or cooking utensils are provided.
- The Hirer is advised to leave nothing of value in the Beach Hut or Pod, as the Council accept no liability for loss or damage to the Hirer's property or injury to any persons using the Beach Hut or Pod except where such injury arises from the negligence of the Council or any matter for which it would be illegal or unlawful for the Council to exclude or limit liability.
- All litter and personal belongings should be removed from the Beach Hut or Pod upon departure and the Beach Hut or Pod must be left in a clean and tidy state.
- Any personal items left at the Beach Hut or Pod will be removed and maybe sold by the Council without incurring any liability for any loss or damage which may occur. The Council shall be entitled to retain any such proceeds of sale absolutely.
- The Council and its authorised representatives may enter the Hut at any time to carry out inspections.
- The Hirer will be responsible for any loss or damage to any Council property and/or equipment during the hire period.
- This booking is not transferable to any other person except at the discretion of the Council. Unreturned or lost keys will incur a £45 charge.
- There will be a £10 administration charge to amend any bookings.
- After a booking has been paid for there will be no refunds for cancellation.
- The Council reserves the right to transfer the Hirer to another Beach Hut or Pod.

Any infringement of these terms and conditions may result in the remainder of the Hirer's booking being cancelled without refund of any part of the hire charge.
