Health and support in Bournemouth

If you are moving to this beautiful area, visiting friends and relatives or on holiday there may be an occasion when you need to visit a local dentist or doctor, find an out of hours pharmacy or hire a mobility scooter for a few days. Hopefully, the information on this page can help guide you in the right direction.

Phoning <u>111</u> will probably be the first place you want to start if you have a health issue and you are unsure about what to do. This is a 24 hour helpline for everyone and is available 7 days a week. There are numerous doctor's surgeries throughout the area but you can find the nearest one to you in Bournemouth <u>here</u>. If you need a pharmacy then there is a large <u>Boots</u> in the town centre which is open daily including Saturday and Sundays. If you need one that is a little nearer to where you are then look at the <u>NHS find a pharmacy</u> website.

<u>Bournemouth Hospital</u> is based just on the outskirts of the town. The hospital includes an emergency department and is open 24 hours a day 365 days per year. Patients will have rapid access to diagnostic equipment and 24 hour emergency theatres. If it's a dentist you require then take a look at the <u>NHS website</u> to find your nearest practice, or ring <u>111</u> if it is an emergency and you do not have a local dentist.

Accessibility and wheelchair hire

The Neighbouring town of Poole also has a <u>Shopmobility service</u>. These vital services are available to anyone, no matter what their mobility impairment is. Whether it is temporary or permanent or caused by illness, pregnancy, accident or age.
