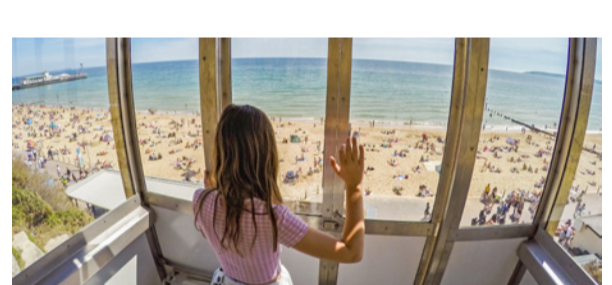

## HOP ON A LAND TRAIN

Bournemouth's famous land trains have been an iconic part of the seafrost for many years, and now you can sit back and enjoy the scenery. Hop on board one of Bournemouth's five famous land trains, running along the promenade eastwards towards Boscombe and the Manor Steps Beach Lodges, westwards towards Branksome Chine, as well as along the clifftop from Manor Steps Beach Lodges via Boscombe precinct and Pier to Bournemouth Pier, for stunning views of the bay.

Prices start from as little as £3.20 per adult for one stage, unlimited travel all day for only £6.00 per person, or £20.00 for a family ticket. See train stops for times and details. Pay once you board the train. Carers travel free, as do children under 5. Trains feature accessible facilities for wheelchair users. Operating from April to October. Subject to weather conditions. In the winter the service only runs at weekends.

## BEACH BARBECUES

Enjoy a barbecue on the beach. Please choose your spot carefully and be respectful to others.

**Bournemouth Beaches:** You will need permission for a barbecue of more than 30 people. Call 01202 451781. You can use a barbecue between 6pm and 10.30pm.

**Poole Beaches:** Barbecues are allowed after 6pm in the designated barbecue area. For parties of more than 12 people (up to a maximum of 80), please check availability with the Beach Office and apply in writing, giving at least seven days' notice. **Safety:** After your barbecue, remember to leave the beach clean and put used barbecues next to one of the seafrost bins. Please do not use gas barbecues and do not put hot barbecues in any bin.

## BEACH HUTS

Our traditional beach huts are available for hire along ten miles of stunning Bournemouth and Poole coastline from Southbourne to Sandbanks. Beach huts are perfect for taking in the spectacular sea views or simply relaxing and watching the world go by.



Beach huts in Bournemouth are located at Alum Chine, Durlley Chine, Bournemouth East and West, Boscombe East and West and Fisherman's Walk to Southbourne. Over at Boscombe Overstrand, near Boscombe Pier, our funky beach pods are also available to hire. Huts are dog friendly and available throughout the year. Daily, weekly and period rates are available and vary according to the time of year. At Bournemouth Pier, enjoy a bite to eat and take in the stunning seaside scenery at Key West Restaurant, while the kids let off some steam at RockReef, the indoor climbing and high wire activity centre. Why not also enjoy a few games at the Pier Amusements or an exhilarating pier-to-shore zip wire?!

**Boscombe Pier:**  
 From Bournemouth Pier, or at various stops along the Bournemouth seafrost, you can catch a **land train** to Boscombe Pier. Here you can enjoy a game of eco mini golf with golf balls that feed the fish or the Musical Train. Nearby are places to eat and drink including restaurants and a beach shop. Best of all, Boscombe Pier is free for a stroll all year round!



## ACCESSIBILITY

Four accessible beach huts are located on the promenade by Boscombe Pier and are available to hire by the day and week. The huts incorporate high quality design, visual flair and unique function. The inside of each hut is a highly adaptable space capable of accommodating up to four wheelchair users at once.

Each hut comes equipped with four director chairs, a table, split level work surface, gas stove, lockable cupboards and shared fresh drinking water tap. Other features include: Fully accessible public toilet, internal shower unit and electric mobility scooter charging point.

There are a further four accessible beach huts at Sandbanks and Branksome Chine in Poole. Contact the Beach Office on 01202 708181 for further information.

**Beach accessible wheelchairs** are available for hire at the central locations of Bournemouth, Boscombe, Sandbanks and Branksome Dene, but can be transported to other areas if needed. The wheelchairs can be booked with 24 hours' notice, and require a small deposit which is returned when the wheelchair is returned. The wheelchairs can only be used during office hours. Call 01202 451781 for information/ to book for Bournemouth beaches, or 01202 708181 for Poole beaches.

**A Mobi-Mat** is a portable rollout pathway that will run from the promenade at Sandbanks Beach directly into the sea, while three Mobi-Chairs will provide transportation across the sand, the mat and into the water at three of Poole's beaches. You can book via the beach office and it's free to hire. Call 01202 708181.

## BEACH SAFETY

Our beaches are some of the safest in the country with professional RNLI beach lifeguards operating during the season. There are zones for swimmers and windsurfers with lifeguard patrols and 'Baywatch' towers to ensure a safe, fun and relaxing time. Rangers regularly patrol seafrost areas throughout the year.

**Sun Safety** slip-slap-slop: slip on a t-shirt, slap on a hat, and slop on the sunscreen.

**Beach Lifeguards** Beach safety is provided in partnership with The Royal National Lifeboat Institution (RNLI). Lifeguards are on duty during the day from May to September.

**Stay Safe** The RNLI is urging anyone thinking of going into the water to choose a lifeguarded beach and swim in the area between the red and yellow flags. **LV=KidZone** Running throughout the school summer holidays, during July and August, children can collect free colour coded wristbands from a seafrost office that match-up with clearly marked designated sections of the seafrost. The LV=KidZone scheme makes a visit to the beach a safer and less stressful experience for parents. Specially trained LV=KidZone staff, as well as seafrost rangers and RNLI lifeguards, are on hand to help reunite missing children with their families.

## DOGS ON OUR BEACHES

Dog walkers can use the Bournemouth and Poole seafrost all year round but, from **1st May to 30th September**, dogs are not allowed on certain sections of Bournemouth and Poole beaches.

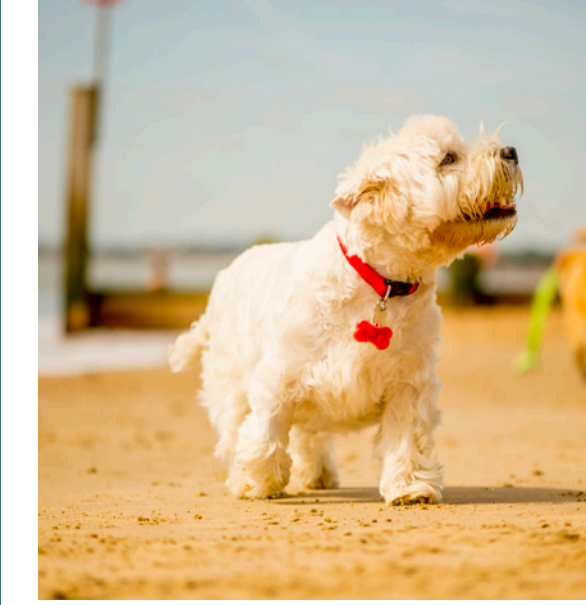
**Use a lead:** During this period, dogs must be kept on a lead when on the promenades, Bournemouth and Boscombe Piers, cliff lifts and zig zags.

**1st May to 30th September:** Dogs are only allowed on designated dog beaches at the eastern end of Branksome Chine to the Poole/Bournemouth boundary and the western end of Sandbanks Beach to Haven Point (see map). In Bournemouth, dogs are not allowed on the beaches from Durlley Chine to Fisherman's Walk near Southbourne during this period.

**Dog friendly beaches:** There are dog friendly beaches at Alum Chine, Durlley Chine, Fisherman's Walk and Hengistbury Head. Eastern side of Branksome Dene to the Poole/Bournemouth boundary and the western end of Sandbanks beach to haven point.

**Don't forget your poo bags!** Please remember that it's a fineable offence to leave dog faeces on the beach.

## CYCLING

Please help us to ensure that Bournemouth and Poole Seafrost remains a safe and enjoyable place for all visitors.

**You can cycle on the promenade along the seafrost**, but please remember to give pedestrians the right of way and keep your speed below 10mph. During July and August, you can only cycle on the promenade before 10am and after 6pm.

**Suggested Cycling Routes:**

**To the east:** Ride from Bournemouth to Southbourne and decide how far you want to go: Hengistbury Head or Christchurch.

**To the west:** Head to the Purbecks. Cycle from Bournemouth to Sandbanks, then hop on the Shell Bay Chain Ferry to Studland and beyond.

**Purbeck Ridgeway:** Great ups and downs! Nothing beats this challenging route.

**The Heritage Cycle Route:** The Heritage Cycle Route is 7.5 miles long, and visits places of historical interest in Poole with beautiful views of the harbour.

**The Bourne Valley Greenway:** Canford Heath to the seafrost in Bournemouth. The return trip is approximately 8 miles.

**The New Forest:** Taking bikes on the train to Brockenhurst is a great day out for exploring the New Forest.

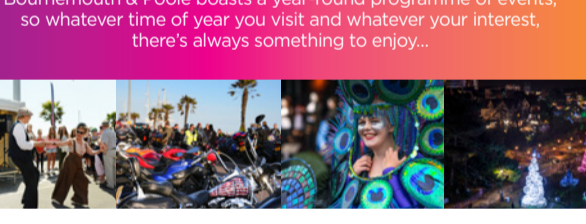

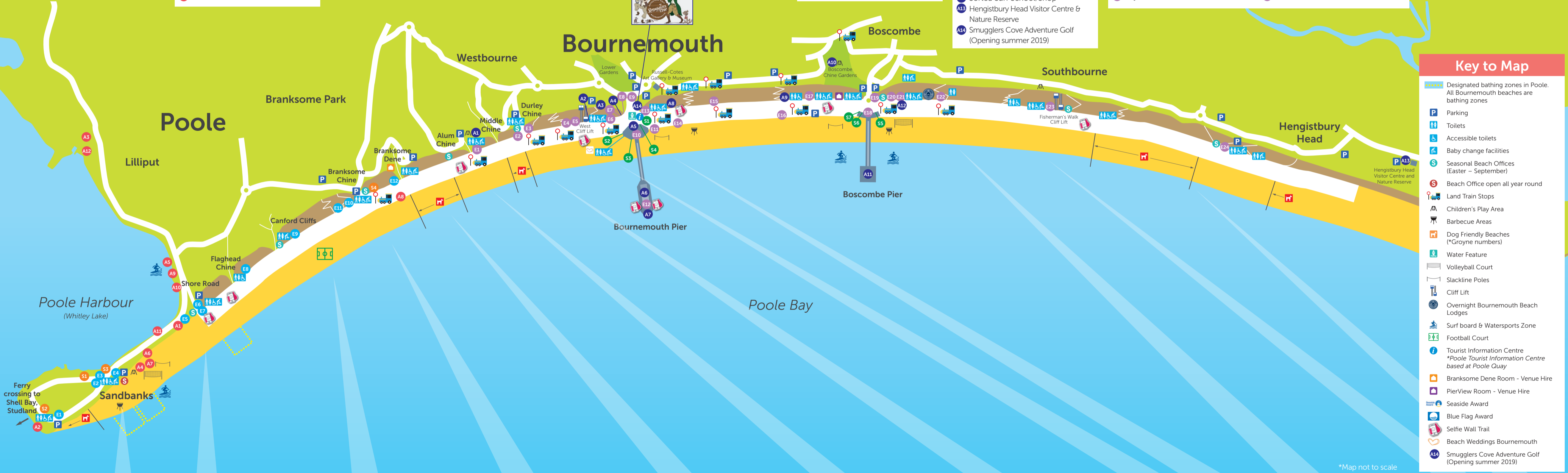
